Uploaded Project, Rubric and Teacher Evaluation on Richer Picture

Math, Science and World Language must have all 3s or 4s on Rubric

Social Studies or English must be an 80 or above

Visual Artwork must be in a tour with teacher evaluation

Keywords that describe SLEs

SLE1 (A1) = critical thinking (research skills, logical problem solving, analyzing info)

SLE2 (A2) = effective communication – reading and writing (also speaking and listening accurately)

SLE 3 (A3) = effective use of technology in research, communication or design

SLE 4 (A4) = demonstrate skills and accomplishments of fine arts

SLE 5 (C5) = understanding of human rights and diversity

SLE 6 (C6) = Understanding of political, social and environmental issues
