

## SENIOR YEARBOOK REFLECTIONS

Dear Seniors,

This year we are allotting you space in the yearbook (next to your senior portrait) for you to share some words you wish to leave behind. As they become a part of the yearbook, we would like them to be positive and follow the guidelines listed below. Remember, this is something that will be published for years to come. Your parents and grandparents, as well as your children and grandchildren, may see this someday!

### Guidelines for Quotes or Parting words:

1. You have a total of **240 characters** (this includes spaces, and punctuation) for you to share either a quote or some parting words. Use the grid on the reverse side to figure out what you can fit.
2. You must leave spaces and use proper punctuation.
3. This reflection is case sensitive. Use lowercase letters with the exception of the beginning of a new sentence and capitalizing proper nouns.
4. If you're including a quote, you must give credit to the author.
5. You may not use initials, abbreviations or acronyms. Please spell out each word.
6. No references to anything that may be deemed inappropriate (drugs/alcohol, sexual remarks, etc.)

***By emailing this to the yearbook staff, you accept all responsibility for your writing and understand that your reflection may be edited or cut due to its length or inappropriateness. You will also accept any consequences that result due to anything you write that is found to be offensive or inappropriate.***

### **Submission Guidelines:**

When you are pleased with your final product, email the following 3 items to [skhsyearbook@yahoo.com](mailto:skhsyearbook@yahoo.com). Please use your first and last name as the subject of the email and include the items listed below as the body of the email. DO NOT send anything as an attachment.

- 1. List of all sports/clubs and the grades that you participated (For ex: Soccer 9, 10, 11, 12)**
- 2. Quote or parting words (total of 240 characters)**
- 3. Career Goal**
